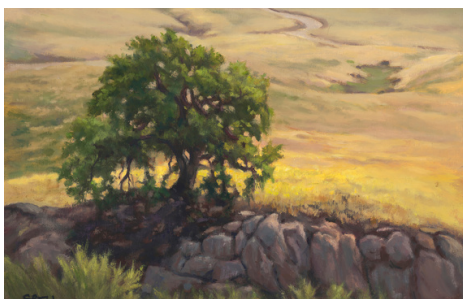


### SANDY FISHER
