A reception will be held and your participation is required by helping to provide refreshments. The reception will be either Saturday, January 17th or 24th.

You must have renewed your dues for 2009 before applying. If you would like to apply please submit the form below. **Deadline to apply is January 5th**. Entrants will be chosen by postmark date, then alphabetically. Those accepted will be notified by January 7th.

The first 14 entrants (not including sculptors) will be in the show, remaining names are wait-listed in case there are cancellations. Be prepared to be called at the last minute. Sculpture will be accommodated providing you bring your own pedestal. There are 5 spaces for freestanding or pedestal sculpture. Each 2D artist has two panels, side by side, or the back and front of one panel. No guarantees. Each panel is 29.5"w x 77"h. Panels have lights.

Ed Davis Park in Towsley Canyon, 24255 The Old Rd, Newhall
661.255.2937: south of Lyons / west of the 5 fwy, southbound on The Old Road, just past the Calgrove exit off the 5, on your right. It’s marked by a state sign and you can see the hikers’ cars parked right there. We park up at the end of the road.



The park offers views of the distant canyon, a small wild creek, manicured lawns, a Spanish villa and many different types of mature trees. The colors of the landscape are muted gold, lavender, greens and rust. There are restrooms available and picnic tables if you care to make use of one. There is a small parking fee of \$5.00 per vehicle. Pay the iron ranger when you drive in, then continue up the road until you reach the last parking lot to your right. We can stay after for an informal discussion on the morning’s efforts if you like.
