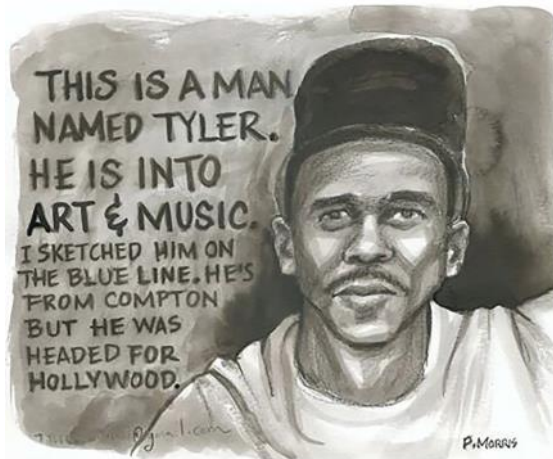

## April 21 — SCAA GENERAL MEETING — April 21



"**SEE LIFE ART**" is the name of Pete Morris' website, and if you like to make art, or look at art, or think Los Angeles is kinda picturesque, even a little, you won't want to miss the Pete Morris Demo at the April 21 meeting of the Santa Clarita Artists Association, 6:30 pm at Barnes & Noble in Valencia.

Pete Morris is passionate about watercolor and has been painting for more than 20 years. About 10 years ago, he decided to try to paint every day, and he has followed through on that to the present. The result is hundreds of watercolors painted each year. Whenever possible, he paints on location, "plein air", but he also does work in his studio.



He is known for his Rte. 66 series, paintings of scenes along the historic highway. Recently, Pete has had exhibits at Vroman's Bookstore Pasadena, Azusa Pacific University, Artshare LA in the Arts District, Archives Bookstore in Pasadena and Sierra Madre City Hall. He posts his ongoing work almost every day on Facebook.

Pete has self-published two books. one is called "Curbside LA," with his sketches of Los

Angeles neighborhoods, done to and from work, and during his lunch hour. The second is called "Riding the Metro," which is sketches of people in their environment on Metro trains and buses. Both books are available at the Blurb.com Bookstore <https://www.blurb.com/bookstore>

You can also see Pete in action in this video entitled Metro Da Vinci on [YouTube](#). He teaches at least 4 watercolor classes a week and a drawing class called Drawing from Observation.

Not only will you be able to see him sketching, you'll learn some stories behind his subjects and the artist himself.

Bob Hernandez graduated from California Institute of the Arts, BFA with honors. Bob was a Design Director for KCBS, Fox Sports Network, Telemundo and has served as Executive Board of The Broadcast Designers Association.

With his own company, Bob Hernandez Design, he lead creative teams in formulating multimedia projects and producing art for such companies as Simon & Schuster, IBM, and Time Warner.

The teaching bug hit years later and Bob got an opportunity to take on a teaching position at California State University Northridge, teaching design and experimental film.

Soon after the multi-media craze hit, both his illustration and design talents began to flourish. His multi-media work for Simon & Schuster on The Amazon Jungle and Animals fo the World has been on display at The Smithsonian Institute.

Though Bob has been nominated several times, won an Emmy, and has various National and International awards during his career, Bob confesses that his true joy is teaching children.

Bob lives with his wife, Diane in Santa Clarita and has two grown sons that are executives in the entertainment industry.



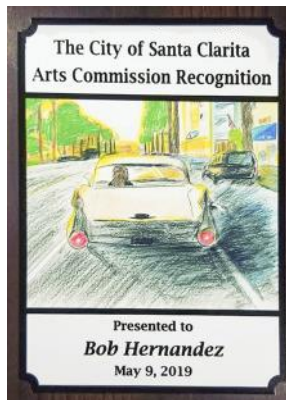

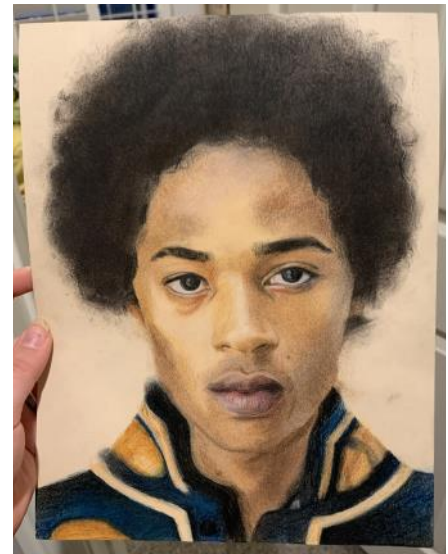

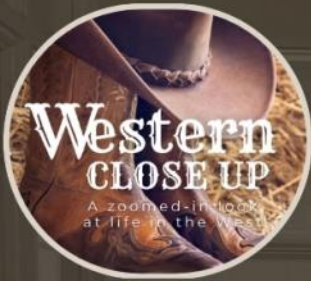

# Santa Paula Art Museum Spotlights Three of SCAA's Best

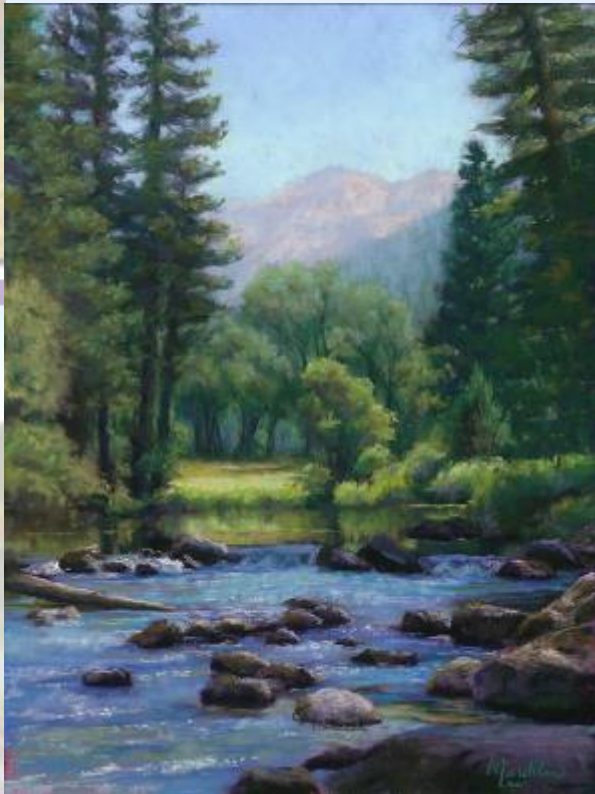
## "A BRUSH WITH NATURE"

Three of Santa Clarita's most talented women artists, each employing a distinct medium will be showcasing over 30 original artworks at the Santa Paula Art Museum (SPAM) in an upcoming exhibit titled "A Brush With Nature: Three Artists' Perspectives." This exhibit will feature oil painter, Sandy Fisher, pastel artist Mardilan Georgio and watercolorist Charlotte Mullich, who have teamed up to present their interpretations of nature, from landscapes and seascapes to flora and fauna. Mardilan Georgio primarily works in pastels and brings seascapes and landscapes to life with realistic color and ethereal strokes which evoke movement and natural forms. Watercolor artist, Charlotte Mullich offers a delicate portrayal of creatures such as birds, butterflies and koi. She uses fluid washes, as well as positive and negative painting to convey the grace and vitality of animals in their habitats.

Sandy Fisher, captures the magic of the landscape and flora with a sense of honesty and nuanced layers of color using strong compositional elements to provide a solid foundation to her artwork.

### SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

All submissions should be sent as attachments to email. We do not like to extract words and pictures from the body of an email. We don't accept submissions as texts on phones.

Written information should be submitted with all pertinent facts checked for accuracy and written in a manner that is ready to publish. We do edit, but try to make it look professional.

We accept MS Word, text and PDF documents. If the PDF is a picture of a flyer with words, we cannot extract those words. If you want us to publish the words as an article, you need to send us a document with words in it.

We accept JPEG, PNG, and TIFF pictures. The smallest acceptable dimension on any picture is 800 pixels. If your picture is of an artwork, it must include the title of the work. The medium, year completed, and location might also be valuable information to include. Of course we need the artist's name.
